this my last Will and testament, in manner and form following; that
is to say; Whereas by the last Will and Testament of Robert Collins deceased
dated on the twelfth day of April, in the year of our Lord one thousand
seven hundred and seventy seven, the said Robert Collins devised to my
the said Sue & her children, named Kelly, Esther, Richard, Charlotte Anne
Ganshorn Eliezer and Robert and a child with which the said Sue
was then envent, all that plantation of him the said Robert Collins

situate in the parishes of Saint Thomas & Dennis, containing four hundred and forty five acres. And Whereas ever since the death of the said Robert Collins, my Mother and her children aforesaid have held & used the aforesaid tract of land in common; partition in the same never having been had, until some of the tenants in common as aforesaid have now died, to wit, five in number, three of whom left issue capable of inheriting; and the other two died intestate and without issue, whereby the said land becomes now divisible into seven shares one of which is justly & of right mine.

In consideration of the kindness and regard always manifested towards me by my Brother Robert Collins, he having afforded me shelter and protection for twenty or twenty five years; In witness, I give & devise to his son, my nephew Henry Collins, all my right, title & interest in and to the said tract of land aforesaid, or to any part thereof to the said Henry Collins and his heirs forever.

Item, I give and bequeath to my said Nephew Henry Collins my negro female slave Sue aged about ten years: to the said Henry Collins and his heirs forever.

Item I give and Bequeath to my said Brother Robert Collins and his heirs forever my female slave Esther aged about five or six and twenty years.

Item I give and Bequeath to my niece Sarah Boag, the daughter of my Brother Robert Collins, my negro female slave Peggy daughter of Yagmay to her and her heirs forever, free from the contract of her present

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of my Brother Robert Collins, to him and his heirs forever, my negro female Slave, named Tia aged about eighteen years.

Item I give and Bequeath to my Nephew Robert Collins, son of my Brother Robert, and his heirs forever my negro female Slave Kate.

Item I give and Bequeath to my Brother Jonathan Collins, during his natural life, and after his death to my nephew Zachariah, the son of my Brother Robert and his heirs forever, my negro male Slave named Glasgow and aged about twenty one years.

Item I give and bequeath to my nephew Henry aforesaid a cow & calf to be selected by him out of all my drove and to have the first choice.

Item I give and Bequeath to my niece Martha, the daughter of my Brother Robert, a cow & calf to be selected by her out of the drove and to have the second choice.

Item I give and Bequeath to my niece Charlotte Blagford, daughter of my sister Rachael a cow and calf and to have the third choice.

Item I give and Bequeath to my Nephew Zachariah aforesaid a cow and calf and to have the fourth choice.

Item I give and Bequeath to my Nephew and Niece aforesaid Henry & Martha all my silver table and tea spoons share and share alike.

Item I devise all the Stock which shall be remaining after my Nephews and Nieces shall have made their selections as above directed and set forth, to be sold by my Executors, to pay off and discharge what

service debt there may be due and owing at the time of my decease.

Lastly I nominate and appoint my Brother Robert Collins & his son Robert Collins Junior Executors to this my last Will and Testament.

In Witness whereof I the said Charlotte Boon have hereunto set my hand and seal this twenty sixth day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty and in the fifty fourth year of American Independence.
