# In the Name of God Amen, I Charles

Lewis of the Parish of Christ Church, in the County of Berkeley Planter  
weak in Body but of Perfect Mind in memory Praised be God & not being Oblivious  
of the Certainty of Death do hereby make and appoint this my Last Will &  
in manner & form following Vizt.

I doth give & Commit my Soul into the hands of Almighty God hoping and  
upwards following the Salvation of it through the alone Merits of my Beloved  
Saviour & Redeemer Jesus Christ & as to the Temporal Estate that it hath pleased  
God to bless me with I give & Every Part thereof to my Dearly beloved Daughters  
Charles Daniel, Mary Elias Thomas Sharlot Lydia & the rest of the Children  
it shall please God to bless me with Equally to be Divided amongst them &  
for their heirs & Assigns for Ever.

And to my wife Elizabeth Lewis I freely Give & bequeath to  
to her the sole Management & Profit of the said Estate for the Maintenance  
of my P. Wife and Children during such time as she shall remaine & b  
widow and at her Marriage or her Disease which shall happen that she  
dies first and Instantly my will and meaning is that all & Every Part of my  
shall be Divided amongst my Children Charles Daniel Elias, Sparus Mary  
Sharlot Lydia & the Rest of the Children it shall please God hereafter  
bless me with Equally & by Equal proportion notwithstanding if it should please  
Almighty God to take himselfe the souls of my Dear Children before they are  
either of Age or Maturity or without Children that then I give to my P. Wife  
Elizabeth Lewis & to her heirs & Assigns for Ever all the余  
Part of the Estate both real & Personal that I am now or shall be hereafter possessed  
I do hereby Nominate Constitute & Appoint my P. Wife Elizabeth Mary Lewis my  
sole Executrix of this my Last Will and Testament & my Trusty & Well Beloved

Son in Law Robert Johnson & Elias Lewis So over See that the same be duly  
Published according to the true intent & Meaning thereof & I do hereby annell  
make void & Contradict all other former Wills by me made to be void & of no  
Effect to Declare this to be my last Will & Testament. In witness whereof

HAVE Given granted and by these Presents Do give grant bargained sold  
and Entitl Convey Assign and Set over unto the said Joseph  
Hough to his heirs & assigns forever one Servt named Anne Eddo  
Lately Imported in this Province and Servanted for Years a Negro Woman  
Slave named Betty with all my household goods of Every Kind such as my Bed  
and furniture Potts Pans Paster Plates Spoons Brushes & all other

Utensells Whatsoeuer that I have in use in my house as also my Working Tools  
in general without Particularizing or mentioning all Which Servant maid  
Negro Woman Household Goods & Working Tools &c. More all of my own  
Property and Purchase before the Inscating her of & are hereby fully & fairly  
Declared & pronounced by me the True Property & Purchase of the said Joseph  
Hough his heirs & Assigns for ever all Which I the said Thomas Snowe do for my  
self his Cators & Administrators Warrant to Make good & defend against the  
claims of all manner of Persons whatsoever Unto the said Hough his heirs &  
In Witness whereof the said Thomas Snowe has set my hand & Seal  
affixed my Seal this Third Day of August Anno Christi One thousand Seven  
hundred Thirty Two
