bargained and sold and by these Presents doth bargain and sell unto the said
James Kinloch Six Negro Women known by the Names Mary, Cook Hobak,
Little Jenny, Subbah, Joan, and Frank, to have & to hold the said Negresses
with their Issue & Increase,和平ly & Respectfully unto the said James
Kinloch his Factors Advers & Aliquines as his or their own Proper Interest &
Chattels & to his and their own Proper Use and Use for ever and if the said
Charles Loundes do for my self my Heirs & Cos and Rector & Covenent to & with
the said James Kinloch his Factors Advers & Aliquines that I the said Charles
at the time of the sealing and Delivery of these Presents am the true
and Lawfull Owner & Proprietor of the said Negresses aforesaid & have
full Power and Authority to bargain, sell and Convey the said Negresses w^t the
Issue Proceed and Increase in manner and form aforesaid and that I shall
Lawfull Sold for the said James his Factors Advers & Aliquines at any time to
take in his Possession & Peaceably have, hold Use and Enjoy the said Negresses
without the Impediment or Interruption of me the said Charles my Factors
Advers & Aliquines or any Person or Persons whatsoever Lawfully claiming or
to claim from by or under me them or any of us, PROVIDED now and at all
times & upon Condition that if the said Charles Loundes my Factors or them
shall Well and Truly pay or Cause to be Paid unto the said James Kinloch his
Factors Advers & Aliquines the said sum of Six hundred Pounds Current
Money aforesaid with Lawfull Interest for the same at or upon the Twenty
Second Day of April which shall be in the next Year of our Lord one thousand
Seven hundred & Thirty Three According to the True Intent and Meaning of
these Presents that then this Present Bargain and Sale of the said Negresses
with their Issue Proceed & Increase & Every thing herein Contained
shall Cease Determine to be totally Void to all Intents & Purposes any Day
hence before Particular to the Contrary notwithstanding the Writings

of April in the year of our Lord one thousand Seven hundred & Thirty Two.
