 Soundes of the Province of South Carolina Esq. send Greeting Know ye
 that I the said Charles Soundes for and in Consideration of the sum of Six
 hundred Pounds Current Money of the said Province to me in hand Paid
 by the Hon^{ble} James Kinloch one of the members of his Majesty's Council
 in the said Province the Receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge HAVE
 bargained and Sold and by these Presents doe bargain and Sell unto the said
 James Kinloch Six Negro Women known by the Names Mary, Cook, Obbah,
 Little Jenny, Subbah, Joan, and Frank, to have & to hold the said Negro Women
 with their Issue ^{procre} Increase, Sincerely & Respectfully unto the said James
 Kinloch his Executors Admors & Assignes as his or their own Proper Interest &
 Chattles & to his and their own Proper Use and Uses for Ever and I the said
 Charles Soundes do for my self my Heirs Executors and Assignes Covenant with
 the said James Kinloch his Executors Admors & Assignes that I the said Charles
 at the time of the Sealing and Delivery of these Presents am the True
 and Lawfull Owner & Proprietor of the said Negroes aforementioned & have
 full Power and Authority to bargain sell and Convey the said Negroes with
 their Issue Procre and Increase in manner and form aforesaid and that it shall be
 Lawfull to and for the said James his Executors Admors & Assignes at any time to
 Take in his Possession & Peaceably have hold Use and Enjoy the said Negroes
 without the Impediment or Interruption of me the said Charles my Executors
 Admors or Assignes or any Person or Persons whatsoever Lawfully Claiming or
 to Claim from by or under me them or any of us, PROVIDED now and at all
 Times & upon Condition That if I the said Charles Soundes my Executors or Admors
 shall Well and Truly pay or Cause to be Paid unto the said James Kinloch his
 Executors Admors or Assignes the said Sum of Six hundred Pounds Current
 Money aforesaid with Lawfull Interest for the same at or upon the Twenty
 third Day of April which shall be in the next Year of our Lord one thousand
 seven hundred & thirty three According to the True Intent and Meaning of
 these Presents that then this Present Bargain and Sale of the said Negro
 Women with their Issue Procre & Increase & Every thing therein contained
 shall Cease Determine & be Totally Void to all Intents & Purposes any Thing
 herein before Contained to the Contrary notwithstanding In Witness
