Eglsman of the City and State aforesaid, Manum, do make and declare  
this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following, that  
is to say, first I resign my soul into the hands of Almighty God, believing  
and hoping for a remission of my sins, and my body I commit to the  
earth to be buried at the discretion of my Executor hereinafter named  
and my worldly Estate I give and bequeath as follows viz:

Item 1<sup>st</sup> I will and devise that all my just debts and funeral ex-  
pences be first fully paid and satisfied

Item 2<sup>nd</sup> Whereas I Christian Eglsman and James Paty, being  
both in sound mind and good understanding have jointly agreed  
that the Survivor should become the heir and enjoy all the property  
both Real and Personal of the one who should first die, I now hereby  
Will and bequeath unto him the said James Paty should he survive  
me, All the residue of the property of which I may die possessed  
of, both Real and Personal, after the payment of all my just debts &  
funeral Expences as aforesaid; But never the less it is understood by  
and between us, that this Will may be revoked at any time hereafter  
should I think proper so to do, by making another Will, the revocation  
of this Will, to have the effect of revoking a Will made by the said  
James Paty of the same tenor of this Will and bearing the same date  
wherein he makes me his heir, in case I should be the longest living  
And I do hereby constitute and appoint him the said James Paty  
my sole Executor of this my last Will.

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Will and bequeath unto him the said James Paty should he survive  
me, All the residue of the property of which I may die possessed  
of, both Real and Personal, after the payment of all my just debts &  
funeral Expences as aforesaid; But nevertheless it is understood by  
and between us, that this Will may be revoked at any time hereafter  
should I think proper so to do, by making another Will, the revocation  
of this Will, to have the effect of revoking a Will made by the said  
James Paty of the same tenor of this Will and bearing the same date  
wherein he makes me his heir, in case I should be the longest living.  
And I do hereby constitute and appoint him the said James Paty  
my sole Executor of this my last Will and Testament. In Witness  
whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal at Charleston this  
thirtieth day of September in the year of our Lord One thousand  
Eight hundred and thirty Four.
