And my worldly Estate I give devise and bequeath, All my Real & personal
Estate of what nature or kind whatsoever & wheresoever to my Beloved Wife
Mary Ann June to her and her heirs forever.

And I hereby nominate and appoint my beloved Wife Mary Ann
June sole Executor of this my last Will & testament.
