Know all Men by these Presents That weo Daniel Astell Esq. and Daniel Astell Esq. both of Dighton in the County of Bristol in the Province of the Massachusetts Bay in New England Planters have Constituted Ordained made and in our Hand and place put and by these presents do Constitute Ordain and make and in our Hand and place put our good and trusty Friend John Draper dwelling at a place called Pond Pond in the County of Worthington in South Carolina Planter to be our true sufficient and lawful Attorney for us and in our Hand and place and to our use to ask, demand, levy, receive, recover, and receive of and from all and every Person and persons whatsoever the same shall and may lawfully singular any Debt or Legacy to us or to either of us given or any ways lawfully belonging or coming unto us Constituents by any means or means whatsoever nothing excepted or reserved in any parts of Carolina aforesaid giving and hereby granting unto Our said Attorney our full and whole Strength power and Authority in and about the premises And to take and use all our means Laws and process in the Law for the Obtaining & Recovering the same and of Damages and Receipt thereof in our Name to make Sol and Execute due Acquittance & Discharges also to make legal Conveyances thereof or any part of the same and for the premises to appear and the person of the said Constituents to represent before any Governor, Judges, Justices, Officers, and Ministers and their or her or either of Our behalfs to answer, defend, and reply unto all Actions, Causes, Matters and Things whatsoever relating to the premises with full power to make & substitute one or more Attorneys under our said Attorney and the same again & pleasure to revoke and lawfully to say do Act Transact Determine Accomplish and Finish all Matters and Things whatsoever relating to the premises as fully and Effectually to all Intents and purposes as weo and Constituents ourselves should Ought or might personally altho the Matters should require more special Authority than is herein Comprised weo and Constituents Ratifying allowing and Holding firm and valid all and whatsoever Our said Attorney has Substituted shall lawfully do or cause to be done in and about by virtue of these presents In witness whereof weo have hereunto set our Hands and Seals the fourth day of November Anno Domini One thousand Two hundred Thine And in the third Year of his Majesty's said
