To all to whom these presents shall
come Daniel Cartwright of the Province of South
Carolina Planter Sends Greeting Whereas
the said Daniel Cartwright in and by a certain
bond or obligation bearing even date with
these presents is become bound unto James
& John of the Province aforesaid Esq.
in the penal sum of One thousand Pieces of
money of the Province aforesaid Conditions for
the true payment of The sum of five hundred &
fifty pounds like current money on the first
day of May next ensuing the date of these presents
as in and by the said Bond or Obligation which
being therunto had more fully & at large appears
Now know ye that the said Daniel Cartwright
for the better securing the payment of the
aforesaid sum of five hundred and fifty pounds
and also for and in Consideration of the sum of
five shillings to him in hand paid by the aforesaid
James & John before the sealing and delivery
of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby
acknowledged It hath granted bargained sold
in plain & open Market delivered, and by these
presents doth Grant bargain sell in plain &
open Market deliver unto the aforesaid James &
John all that certain Negro man Slaves commonly called
known by the names of Tom, Quach, Dick, Philip, Potkin
Pined January, Pompey Lemmy & Johnathan
To have and To hold the aforesaid ten

Negro man Slaves unto the aforesaid James &
John his heirs assigns and assigns for ever
And the aforesaid Daniel Cartwright for himself
his heirs assigns & assigns the aforesaid ten
Negro man Slaves unto the aforesaid James &
John his heirs and assigns and assigns shall
and will warrant & for ever defend by these
presents of all and every person or persons
Whatsoever Provided and upon Condition
nevertheless that if the aforesaid Daniel Cartwright
his heirs assigns or assigns shall and dole
and truly pay or cause be paid unto the aforesaid
James & John his heirs assigns or assigns
the full and just sum of five hundred and fifty
pounds like current money of the Province aforesaid
on or before the first day of May next ensuing the
date of these presents according to the Condition
of the above recited obligation and that without
any Deduction of payment or abatement
or otherwise for or in respect of any Taxes Charges
or impositions that have been or to be taxed
Levyed or imposed on the premises or upon
the said Daniel Cartwright by reason hereof
That then this present Grant bargain and sale
and every clause matter & thing herein contained
shall cease determine be utterly void to all intents
and purposes whatsoever any thing herein contain
to the contrary thereof in anywise notwithstanding

Cartwright hath hereunto set his hand
& seal this first day of May in the fifth year
of the Reign of our Sovereign Lord George the
Second by the Grace of God Great Britain
France & Ireland King Defender of the faith

Mortgage by John Hill to Gideon Clapp

I know all men by these presents that John Hill
(Hill of Berkeley County in the province of Georgia)
Planters for and in consideration of the sum of Five
Shillings Current money of the said South
Carolina State in hand paid by Gideon Clapp
of Berkeley County in the said Province of South
Carolina March 1st Whereof hereby acknowledge
the receipt and also for and in consideration of
a bona obligation bearing even date with
these presents Wherein the said John Hill
is held firmly bound unto the said Gideon Clapp
in the personal sum of One thousand & Seven
hundred ten Shillings Current money of the
said South Carolina Conditioned for the
payment of Five hundred and three pounds
and fifty six Shillings like Current money
on the first day of February next ensuing
as by the said written obligation & Condition
both more at large appear And for the better
securing the said sum of Five hundred and
three pounds & fifty six Shillings to be paid as
aforesaid Have bargained sold and delivered
and by these presents in due form of said S.
bargain sold and deliver unto the said Gideon
Clapp his Executors Administrators & assigns Three Negro
men by name London Herrford and Bristol
& One Negroe Boy by name Poppy To have &
to hold the said Bargained premises unto the said
