 the said Daniel Macintosh Deceased & also the Auditing the Accounts Calculations &
 Disbursements of the said Admiror and a final Dismission of the said to said manifestly
 known to belong & deriving that the Goods Rights & Credits of the said Deceased may be
 well and truly Administered Committed and disposed of & whereby Granting to the said
 James Margilray (in whose fidelity in this behalf I very much Confide) full power by
 the Tenor of these presents to Administer the Goods Rights and Credits of the said Deceased
 which to him in his Life time and at the time of his Death did belong, due to Ask,
 Demand, pay, recover and receive the same and to pay the Debt in which the Deceased
 stood Obliged so far forth as the said Goods Rights & Credits will Extend according to
 the rate & Order of Law being first sworn on the holy Evangelists of Almighty God
 to make a true and perfect Inventory thereof and to Exhibit the same into the Secretarys
 Office at Charles Town in Order to be Granted at or before the first day of April now
 next ensuing and to render a true and just Oath Calculations & Disbursement of the said
 Admiror when thereunto required And I Do Ordain Depute & Constitute You
 the said James Margilray Admiror of all & singular the Goods Rights & Credits of the
 said Deceased.

in the Province of South Carolina planter being now in perfect Health and of full

therefore these presents to bring last Will and Testament hereby, Revoking and annull
null and void all former Wills and Testaments by me here before made First I Com
Soul to God hoping by the merits of my blessed Saviour Jesus Christ to have full pa
of all my sins As to my Body I Comitt it to the Earth to be decently buried at the
Discretion of my Executors herein after named In the next place I Order that all
Debts that I Ow and several Charges be paid in Season after my Decease and
my temporal Estate I Give and dispose of the same in manner following First I Give
unto Edwards the eldest Daughter of Edward Edwards formerly first Owner of
being part of a Tract of Land of One hundred Acres commonly called Edwards piece
said Land not to be in the power of the said Edwards nor his wife or Children
of the said Land but to be in the power of my Executors to Act and Dispose of the
Child till she attain the Age of sixteen or the Day of her Marriage, but in Case
Child should dye before she attain the Age aforesaid then the said Land to fall to the
Mrs Mary Edwards but in Case both should fail or dye then the said Land to fall to the
Widow of Charles Town Item I Give to my Negro Boy Joseph his Freedom
Slavery from me my Heirs Executors or Assigns for ever to him and his Heirs for
