the said goods being first sworn on the Holy Evangelists
of Almighty God to make a full & perfect Inventory &
Appraisal of the same to be returned under your hands
or of any three or four of you into the said Office in Charley
town in order to be Recorded on or before the first
day of March next ensuing

To all to whom these Presents shall come Greeting
Know ye that on the fourth day of September in the year of Our
said One thousand seven hundred & twenty nine the last Will &
Testament of Andrew Warnock Dec^d was proved, approved & allowed
of the said Dec^d having when he lived & at the time of his Death
divers goods rights & credits within the Province aforesaid by means
whereof the execution & allowing of his Testament & the power of
granting the Dominion of all & singular the Goods rights & Credits
of the said Dec^d and also the Auditing the Receipts & Disbursements
of the said Dec^d & the final Disposition & discharge
from the same to me is manifestly shewn to belong And that the
Dominion of all the singular the Goods rights & Credits of the said Dec^d
of their Testament any manner of way concerning was committed unto
Mary Warnock his Widow Joseph Warnock his Son & Michael
Dorby named Executors in the said Will & Testament being sworn on
the Holy Evangelists of Almighty God well & faithfully to accom-
plish & to make a full & perfect Inventory of all & singular the Goods
rights & Credits of the said Dec^d & to exhibit the same into the
said Office in Charley town in order to be Recorded on or before the
first day of January next ensuing & to render a just & true and Calculations & Accounting
thereof when thereunto required
