this my Will and Testament, First, I direct that all of my lawful debts be
paid as soon after my decease as possible, out of the first moneys that shall
come into the hands of my Executors from any portion of my Estate real or personal.
Secondly, I give and bequeath to my Wife, Rebecca Burbage all my Household
and Kitchen furniture, my Stock of Hogs and the rest and residue of my stock of
Cattle after each of my older Children have taken their Cow and Calf out the stock,
(to viz Joshua, Jane, Rebecca, Daniel, Alexander, Christianna, Hannah, and
Lovey, Laury) Each of the aforesaid Child is to have a Cow and Calf of which their
died of Gift calls for). Also I give and bequeath to my Wife Rebecca Burbage, all
that Plantation or tract of Land whereon I now reside containing sixty five acres,
To have and to hold the aforesaid, household and Kitchen furniture, Stocks of Hogs and
Cattle, and all that Plantation or tract of land, to her use for and during the term of
her natural life, after her death my Will is, that the aforesaid, Household and Kitchen
furniture, the Stocks of Hogs Cattle, and all that Plantation or tract of land contain-
ing sixty five acres more or less, are to be given to my youngest ^{son} Ransom Burbage,
To Have and to hold the same unto him and his heirs and assigns forever. And final-
ly I do hereby constitute and appoint my Friends, John R. and Sterling S. Dainger-
field, sole Executors of this my last Will and Testament. In witness whereof I
have hereunto set my hand and seal This Twentyeight day of January, in the
year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and Forty two and in the sixty six
year of American Independence — Daniel ^{his} Burbage ^{mark} (P.P.)

Also I give and bequeath to my Wife Rebecca Burbage, all that Plantation or tract of Land whereon I now reside containing Sixty five acres, To have and to hold the aforesaid, household and Kitchen furniture, Stocks of Hogs and Cattle, and all that Plantation or tract of land, to her use for and during the term of her natural life, after her death my Will is, that the aforesaid, Household and Kitchen furniture, the Stocks of Hogs Cattle, and all that Plantation or tract of land contain-
