Item, I give & devise unto my brother John W Davies, his heirs and assigns, forever, all that my farm or real estate lying in the neighbourhood of Charleston aforesaid. Upon Trust that my said Brother, his heirs or assigns, shall at the proper time, sell the said Land or real estate, upon the most judicious terms, and after satisfying the lien now resting on the same, hold the residue of the purchase-money to the use of my Executor hereinafter named. Item, after the payment of my funeral expenses and just debts as aforesaid, I give devise and bequeath all the rest, residue and remainder of my estate and effects, real, personal and mixed, including the nett proceeds of the sale of my said farm near Charleston, unto my mother Rachel Davies my Sister Mary Ann, to them their executors, administrators and assigns, forever, as tenants in common, share and share alike. Lastly, I hereby nominate and appoint my said Brother John W Davies Executor of this my last will and Testament: hereby revoking any former will by me heretofore made and declaring and executing this alone as & for my Last Will & Testament.
