I give the said Plantation and negroes to my grand nephew Henry W Ravens
and his heirs and assigns forever.

Then I give and devise to my grand nephew Henry L Stevens my plan-
tation called Hamaker with all the lands adjoining thereto with all the neg-

pass them up to him and his heirs and assigns forever, but in case of his death before he arrives at the age of twenty one years, then I give and devise the same to him and his heirs and assigns to my grand nephew William F. Ravelle, his heirs & assigns forever.

Item I do hereby require that my Executors hereafter named shall pay to my niece Susan M. Stevens, Maria Ravelle, Mary M. Broughton, Caroline Maggick and the Representatives of my nephew John F. Ravelle and niece Charlotte Porcher, each the sum of Five hundred Dollars out of the profits & income of my Estate. All the rest and residue remainder of my Estate I give and devise to my nephew Henry Ravelle and my niece Susan M. Stevens, Maria Ravelle, Mary M. Broughton and Caroline Maggick, to be equally divided between them share and share alike, And I do hereby require of my Executors, that they put my Mulettie Boy Slave named Phelps out to a trade and if possible to give him his freedom. Lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint my nephew Henry Ravelle & Benjamin P. Ravelle and my grand nephew Henry W. Ravelle Executors of this my last Will and Testament.
