Letter of Edward to David Dolly granted to Charles Hill

By the Honble Arthur Middleton Esq. President and
 Commander in Chief in and over his Majesty's Provinces
 of South Carolina and Ordinary of the same

To Charles Hill of Charles Town Merchant

Whereas David Dolly late of Saint Bartholomew's Parish in this Province
 deceased lately did intestate having sole and at the time of his
 several Goods Rights and Credits within the Province aforesaid, by whom were
 his full Disposition and power of granting the same to all and singular
 Good Men his and Credits after the said David Dolly deceased and also the said
 his Account, Balance and other Rights of the said Administration, and a full
 Disposition of the same to be manifestly known to belong to him being that
 Goods Rights and Credits of the said deceased may be well and truly assigned to
 his Executors and Disposed of to be fully Grant unto the said Charles Hill in
 full satisfaction in this behalf being made by the full power by the Court of the said
 Administrator the Goods Rights and Credits of the said deceased which he has in his
 hand and at the time of his death did belong and to ask Collection by, Goods
 Rights and Credits and to pay the Debts in which the said deceased was obliged except
 as the said Goods Rights and Credits will before according to their rate and value
 being first sworn on the Holy Evangelists of Almighty God to make a true and full
 Inventory thereof and to exhibit the same unto the Secretary's Office at Charles Town
 in or before the first Day of May next approaching and her
 Just and true Account Balance and Working of the said Administration shall

 In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my Hand
 and the Seal of the said Province — Day of December in

 Inventory thereof and to exhibit the same unto the Secretary's Office at Charles Town
 in or before the first Day of May next approaching and her
 Just and true Account Balance and Working of the said Administration shall
