Whereas David Durham Esq: late of this Province Deceased lately dying
In a state having whilst he lived and at the time of his Death divers Goods
Rights and Credits within the Province aforesaid by means of his full
Disposition and power of granting the control of all and Singular his Goods
Rights and Credits of his said David Durham Deceased and also his debts
the account Calculated and following of divers Administrations and a final
Disposition of the same to him Manifly known to belong Desiring that
the said Rights & Credits of his said Deceased may be well and truly
Administered Calculated and Disposed of so hereby Grant unto the said Lydia
Durham in whose Fidelity in this behalfe I very much Confidefull power
by the Tenor of these presents to Administer the Goods Rights and Credits of
his said Deceased which to her in his life time and at the time of his Death
did belong And to ask Collect every Revenuer and Receive the same and to pay
the debts in which his Deceased stood Obliged so far forth as his said Goods
Rights and Credits will extend according to their rate and value of same being
first given to the Holy Evangelists of Almighty God to make a hab and
perfect inventory thereof and to deliver the same into the Registry in the
place in Order to be Registered on or before the first day of May next
following And to render a just and true account Calculated and Calcul
of his said Adminr when thereunto required And I Do Ordain
before me Constitute you the said Lydia Durham Administrator of his said Deceased
and Singular the Goods Rights & Credts of his said Deceased
