 Town Province aforesaid High-Master being Sound in Mind and Memory Bu-
 weak in body and knowing that Life is uncertain and Death Certain and that
 is the Duty of Every Christian to Disentangle himself of all his Worldly affairs
 make and ordain this my last Will and Testament. Firstly Revoking & Disannul-
 ling all former Wills & Testaments I Recommend my Soul to God that gave
 it to my Body to the ground to be Decently Buried at the Discretion of my
 Executor after Manner of M. it is my Will that all my Lawfull Debts be
 first paid and as to what Remained I will give and Bequeath the whole
 Bonds, Bills, Book Debts, Wearing-apparel to generally all & whatsoever
 Belongs to me at the time of my Decese unto my Well-beloved friend
 David Linn Ship Carpenter to sell further Give and Bequeath unto my
 Beloved Brother, Watson Living in Scotland in North Britain, all
 all my Interest I have in the said Town of Leith & which was More.

Personally signed in & power was made by said my said Brother &
 I do by this Presents with Consensus & Ordains the said David Linn to
 be sole Executor & Decerned this to be my last Will and Testament
 with other att. WITNESSE my hand the Twenty first Day of July one
 thousand seven hundred and thirty two and of his Majesty's Reign the
