The Twelfth day of November Anno Domini One thousand  
Seven hundred and Thirty the Doctorina Thompson of  
Savannah in the parish of Christchurch County  
of Beaufort and Province of South Carolina being very sick  
and her body but of perfect mind and memory thanks  
be to Almighty God for it Therefore Calling to  
mind the mortallity of my body and knowing that it is appointed  
for all men once to die Do make and ordain this my last  
Will and Testament of it to my Principall and first  
full I give and recommend my Soul into the hands of  
Almighty God Who gave it to me By I recenad to the Earth  
to be buried in a decent Christian Manner at Discretion of  
my Executor Nothing doubting but at the General Resurrection  
I shall receive the same again by The Almighty power of  
God as touching such worldly Estate Wherewith it hath  
pleased God to bless me in life I give demise and disposse  
of the same in the following manner and forme

I M P R U M I S / Will order and appoint that my  
General Charges with all my other debts which I justly  
Owe to any other person or persons be well and truly paid  
and discharged. Item I leave Order and appoint  
My Whole Estate <sup>and good</sup> and Chattels to the wife of  
and wife of Mary Thompson my Wif during her being my  
Widow

Ilem if my said W<sup>r</sup>fe, Mary Tomson altereth her  
Condition by marriage I Will and appoint that my  
said Goods and Chattels be equally divided among all  
my Children and my said W<sup>r</sup>fe Mary Tomson but  
with this Only Exception following Vizt.

That I give W<sup>r</sup>l and bequeath my Gallows before do-  
Black over to my Daughters Elizabeth Tomson  
to be equally divided among them

Ilem I Will Broker and appoint that whatsoever  
part of my Estate falls to my Daughter Sarah  
I beof she & before her issue and the heirs of her body  
forever And for the Execution of this my Last  
Will and Testament I constitute and appoint  
my Well beloved friends Mr John Huggins &  
Mr W<sup>r</sup>m Scroon as my Sole Executors  
Revoking and disannulling all former W<sup>r</sup>ds  
Legacy and bequests whatsoever In Witness  
Whereof I set to my hand and Seal this twelfth
