In the first place I desire that after my decease that my body be decently
interred, and then that all my lawfull debts together with my funeral ex-
penses be paid. - In the next place I will and desire that whatever
amount in money or in Value shall remain after the payment of my law-
ful debts that it be divided in the following manner, viz. To my dear
Sister Catharine Doyle Spinster I will and bequeath One third amount
of my property both real and personal or its value. To my dear Sister
Mrs. Eliza Prendergast I will and bequeath another One third of my
property both real and personal - And to the children of my dear Brother
Patrick Doyle deceased - I will and Bequeath another third - And that
this my last Will and Testament be rightly understood by my Executors
hereafter mentioned, I desire all the afore mentioned persons (namely my
Two Sisters and the children of my Brother Patrick Doyle deceased, are in
each One third to have share and share alike - and that this my last Will
and Testament be properly and honestly executed I constitute will and
appoint Mr. John Hunter and the Rev. J. O'Neill as my lawfull Executors
of this my last will and Testament who may sell or dispose of my prop-
erty both real and personal as it may seem good to them for the benefit
of my heirs &c Estate and I am In witness whereof this 1st day of

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Two Sisters and the children of my Brother Patrick Doyle deceased, are in
each one third to have share and share alike - and that this my last Will
and Testament be properly and honestly executed I constitute will and
appoint Mr. John Hunter and the Rev. J. O'Neill as my lawful Executors
of this my last Will and Testament who may sell or dispose of any prop-
erty both real and personal as it may seem good to them for the benefit
of my heirs &c Estate and I. - In witness whereof I place this my hand
