To all people to whom these presents shall come
I Edward Scott of the Parish of St. Helena Planters
for & in consideration of the Sum of Six hundred
& fifty pounds South Carolina Currency to me
in hand as & before the sealing & Delivery of these
presents well & truly paid by John Benstone of
the Parish of Christ Church in the Province
aforesaid the Receipt whereof I do here by Acknowledge
have bargained & sold by these presents do bargain
& sell unto the said John Benstone three Negroes
one called Hitta & Canterbury man & Nagger
a woman To have and to hold the
bargained premises unto the said John Benstone
his Ex^{or} Adm^r & Assignes to the proper use &
behoofe of the said John Benstone his Ex^{or} Adm^r &
Assignes for ever & the said Edward Scott for my
self my Ex^{or} & Adm^r the said bargain of premises
unto the said John Benstone his Ex^{or} Adm^r &
Assignes against all persons shall & by warrant
& for ever Defend by these presents provided
always & it is hereby agreed between the said
parties to these presents that if the said Edward
my Ex^{or} Adm^r & Assignes or any of us do & shall
not truly pay or cause to be paid unto the
said John Benstone his Ex^{or} Adm^r & Assignes the
Sum of Six hundred & fifty pounds the aforesaid
Currency on the first of January next which will be
in the Year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred
& twenty nine Day of for Redemption of the said
hereby bargained premises then this present bill of
Sale & every clause Article & thing therein contained
shall for ever Determine & be utterly Void any thing

hereinbefore contained in any wise notwithstanding

& in the second Year of his maj^{ty} King George the Third
