or outward bound from the Said Province
And to do all and perform all such matters
and things as to the Office of Naval Officer
for any of his Majestys Plantations or Colonies
in America doth in any wise appertain or belong
To have & to hold the Said Office of Naval
Officer during my Pleasure Together with
all fees perquisites & profits Incident to the said
Office

Ward for my self my heirs Executors and
Assigns the said bargained promised unto the
said W. Hazard his Executors admin^r & assigns
all and all in manner of persons shall and will
Warrant & forever Defend by these presents
I know Whereof together with the delivery of the
said bargained promised I have hereunto set my
hand and seal this first day of June in the
fifth year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lord
George the Second by the Grace of God of Great
Brittain France & Ireland King Defender

said George Bampfild his Ex^{rs} and assigns
That the said William Osborne have not hitherto
nor shall or will at any time hereafter Do or cause
to be done any act or thing whatsoever whereby
or by means whereof the said Perriague or any of the
said Perriague shall or may be in anywise Charged
or Incumbered In this Estate or other wise Thawo-
ever But shall and will at any time hereafter Det
