18th State of South Carolina, The last Will and Testament of Elizabeth Hutchinson of Charleston Widow— To my Grandson Thomas Hutchinson I give and bequeath my house and lot on Sullivan's Island and all the Furniture, that may be in the House— To my Grandson Thomas Leger Hutchinson I give One thousand Dollars to be paid him immediately after my decease and also all my Table and bed Linen.

To my Grand children Thomas Holland Hutchinson, Elizabeth Hosack and
Maras Leger Hutchinson, I give and bequeath all my silver Plate to be equally divided
among them and to be delivered to them at my decease. To my Cousin Mrs. Mary
Mathews wife of Captain Benjamin Mathews, I give and bequeath the sum of
five hundred dollars and all my wearing apparel, the money to be paid and the
apparel to be delivered immediately after my decease, but if the should not be alive
at my decease, I then order that the money be paid and the apparel to be given
to her children equally to be divided among them. All the rest and residue
of my Estate whatsoever and wheresoever, I order to be sold as soon as convenient
after my death and the proceeds to be divided as follows. One half to be given to
my Grand son Thomas Leger Hutchinson and the remaining half to be divided
between my Grand son Thomas Holland Hutchinson and my Grand daugh-
ter Elizabeth Hosack. To my Executors herein after named, I give my beloved
