Item I give to my Friend Eliza Emily Thurston my set of Scotts Bible.

Item I give to my friend John Gough North, a mourning Brooch to be purchased for him by my Executors hereinafter named.

Item I give to my niece Martha Mathe ~~Dart~~ Robinson my Gold watch, chain and trinkets, which I wear and also my Books & Book case.

Item. All the rest and residue of my Estate, consisting of my furniture in my rooms, (not herein before given away) my wearing apparel, monies stock or choses in action, I give to my niece Martha Mathe Robinson and Susan Mary Vance: my said niece Martha Mathe Robinson to take One thousand Dollars more than my niece Susan Mary Vance.

I in cases in action, I give to my niece Martha Motte Robinson and Susan Mary Vance: my said niece Martha Motte Robinson to take One thousand Dollars more than my niece Susan Mary Vance, because of an advancement made to the latter by her Father the late Thomas S. Dart to their sole and separate use, and not subject to the debts contracts or contracts of their present or any future Husband, and I desire that their separate receipts alone shall be considered a sufficient discharge to my Executors for the same.

Item. It is my express will and desire that no Hoods or scarfs or crapes be purchased for my funeral.

Lastly I hereby nominate and appoint my worthy friends General James Hamilton and Doctor Edward Washington North Executors of this my last Will and Testament, hereby revoking all and every other will and testament by me at any time heretofore made.
