South Carolina In the name of God, Amen, I, Elizabeth Mitchell of the City of Charleston, widow, knowing the uncertainty of life do make and declare this my last will and testament as follows that is to say. I give and bequeath unto my beloved niece Sarah Ann Marshall my negro Wench Flora and her daughter Kitty together with any future issue they may have but should I in my life time sell and dispose of said negroes then the amount of the net proceeds of such sale I give to my said niece - Item. I give and bequeath unto my niece Mary Carolina Marshall my negroes Mary and Ben and any issue which said Negro Mary may have at my decease, but in case I should previously dispose of them then the amount of the net proceeds of such sale I give to my said niece Mary Carolina Marshall - Item, I give and bequeath unto my niece Margaret Charler my Mulatto Girl named Charlotte the Eldest Daughter of Caphne - Item - The one hundred Dollars borrowed from me by my brother the Rev. John W. Charler, I give and bequeath unto my said Brother - My negro boy George I give to my Nephew the Rev. Alexander W. Marshall - All my interest in the Lot at Hampstead on Charleston Neck I give and devise to the heirs at law of my deceased Sister Mrs. Mary S. Marshall. And all the rest and residue of my Estate real and personal I give devise and bequeath unto my said nieces Mary Carolina and Sarah Ann Marshall & their heirs and assigns forever. - Lastly, I appoint my Nephew Thomas Charler Marshall and my stepson John W. Mitchell Executors of this my will hereby revoking all former wills by me made - Witness my hand & seal this first day of April one thousand eight hundred and thirty seven. Elizabeth Mitchell

I, Eliza Mitchell as a Codicil to my foregoing Will do hereby obliterate the clause in the same relating to the disposition of my portion of the Hampstead lot inherited from my Mother it not having been expressed according to my instructions and instead of it, I hereby now insert the following namely — I have disposed of all my right title & interest in the lot of land in the village of Hampstead Charleston S. C. to my Brother John M. Chandler for the sum of Two hundred & fifty dollars being my portion of the One thousand dollars which it was agreed upon between my Sister Marshall myself & Brother as heirs to be the value of the whole lot he paying us our portion as should be convenient to him with interest from the date of purchase and the obligation he has given & I have received making them void.

154 The above sum of two hundred & fifty dollars for my portion of the lot. I have
now appropriated towards the payment of Mr Walker for the repairs of the house
when it was injured by the Tornado and payment of my portion of the taxes
upon the lot from the time my sister Marshall commenced paying, the
whole of them to the time of my Brother purchasing my sister Marshall's por-
tion & my own - This appropriation being all that I intend to give towards the
payment of Mr Walker's debt - Furthermore it is my will that my Brother
J W Chandler shall not be distressed or forced to settle his obligation to me
for said sum of two hundred & fifty dollars but confide to his honor and
candor to cancel the debt as soon as he conveniently can - Witness my
hand and seal this nineteenth day of November A.D. 1837 -
