McDonald the Executors of this my last Will and Testament, giving to them or such one of them as shall qualify, power to sell all and every such part and parts of my Estate real and personal as they may deem it proper to sell in order to carry into effect the provisions of this Will: hereby revoking all former and other Wills by me at any time heretofore made, and I do declare this to be my last Will and Testament.
