To Gabriel Manigault of Charleston Merchant

Whereas Ethor Mountjoy late of Charleston in
 the Province of said Deeds lately died intestate having
 whilst she lived and at the time of her death several goods

 of the said Deeds and a final Disposition of the same same
 is manifestly known to belong & answering that the goods
