weak in Health but of sound and disposing mind Memory and understanding
do make this my last Will and Testament in manner following. that I do
give and bequeath to my Sister Charlotte C P Ross Five hundred Dollars

as a mark of my love and affection. I give to my Executors and Executors hereinafter named the sum of Ten thousand Dollars to be invested by them in Bonds, Stocks, the income or dividends arising therefrom to be paid to my Sister Mary McKim during her natural life for her use and benefit and after her decease I give the Capital to my Children Samuel McKim, Thomas E McKim, Mary McKim and Fitzgerald R McKim, or such of them as shall then be living to be equally divided among them share and share alike. And if either of my said Children should die in the lifetime of my said Sister leaving issue, such issue is to take by representation the share to which such Child would have been entitled if living at my Sisters death. All the rest residue and remainder of my Estate whatever and wheresoever which I may have or be entitled to at the time of my death I give and bequeath to my said Children Samuel, Thomas E, Mary and Fitzgerald R McKim to be equally divided among them share and share alike, and it is my Will that all the property herein and hereby bequeathed to my said Children shall be held and managed by my Sister Mary McKim in trust for them till they respectively attain the age of twenty one years and that the same shall be under the control of no other Guardian as long as she may live. The object for which it is my most anxious desire to provide, is that my Children shall be brought up and educated in the manner that will tend most to their happiness and benefit, and it is my earnest wish that they shall not be separated, but shall live together. My Sister Mary McKim has assisted me in taking care of them from their infancy and as I have the highest confidence in her discretion and judgment and they are much attached to her, it is my wish that my said Sister should act as the Guardian of their persons and I desire that she be chosen their Guardian if it is necessary for

their happiness and benefit, and it is my earnest wish that they shall not be separated, but shall live together. My Sister Mary McKoss has assisted me in taking care of them from their infancy and as I have the highest confidence in her discretion and judgment and they are much attached to her, it is my wish that my said Sister should act as the Guardian of their persons and I desire that she be chosen their Guardian if it is necessary for them to make a choice. W^m Burwell Royken has been appointed with my consent Guardian of the Estate they inherited from their Father and thereby repeat my willingness that the same should continue under his management and control, having entire confidence in him. Lastly I nominate constitute and appoint my Sister Mary McKoss Executor and my friend Samuel H Mortimer Executor of this my last Will and Testament.
