 Sealed & Delivered & by these presents do bargain & sell
 Sign Seal & Deliver unto the said Andrew Duleh his
 heirs, Ex^{ors} or Assigns one Bay more named Betty one
 Percegon now a building at Bahamans point together
 with all the timber boards house frames & on the said
 point to have & to hold for ever in witness whereof I
 have hereunto set my hand & seal this 1st Day of June
 1729
