In the Name of God Amen I, Francis Rutledge an inhabitant of the parish of St. James Goose Creek in the District of Charleston and State of South Carolina, being of sound mind & memory, but weak & feeble in body from the infirmity of age and aware of the uncertainty of life and of the certainty of my approaching decease, do make, ordain, establish and publish this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking and disannulling all other Wills by me heretofore made, or published, in manner and form following (Viz) -
Item first - I direct that immediately after my decease (as circumstances may permit) my lifeless body be decently interred in the burying ground of the Cusack Family upon or near the Wapannawan Swamp the expenses of my funeral shall be paid by my qualified Executor out of the first monies that may come into their hands -

I Item second the whole of the proceeds of my Estate be it goods or chattels right or ready money which may be left by me after the payment of my funeral expenses and all Just debts by account or otherwise - I give and bequeath to my friends Peter H. Cusack and his sister Mary, O. Earnest to be equally divided between the said Peter, and Mary, in equal proportion share and share alike to them and their heirs and assigns forever - Lastly I hereby appoint my friend Peter H. Cusack Executor of this my last Will and Testament in witness whereof I hereby set my hand and seal this 25th day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and forty three and in the Sixty seventh year of the independence of the U. S. of America
