This Indenture made the thirtieth Day of January in the year of Our Lord One thousand seven hundred and twenty ninth the third year of the reign of our Sovereign Lord George the third by the Grace of God of Great Britain France and Ireland King Supreme of the Faith &c. Between George Johnson of Charles Town in said Province of Maryland one Part and Daniel Greene Esq. and Jacob Woolford of said County in said Province of the other part Witnesses That the said George Johnson for and in consideration of the Sum of One thousand pounds Current Money of said Province to him in hand paid at or before the Executing and Delivery of these Presents well and truly paid by the said Daniel Greene Esq. and Jacob Woolford the Receipt whereof he doth hereby acknowledge Hath Bargained sold Assigned Transferred and Set over and by these Presents doth Bargain sell Assign Transfer and Set over unto the said Daniel Greene Esq. and Jacob Woolford all and singular the Sums and Sums of Money Bonds and Notes and all and singular the Goods Chattels Wares Merchandises and Negroes as by a Schedule hereunto annexed against all Claims and demands whatsoever without Enquiry or Equity of him the said George Johnson or of or to the same and of and in and to every part and Part of them of To Have hold receive Perceive and Enjoy all and singular the said Sums of Money Bonds and Notes and all and singular the Goods Chattels Wares Merchandises and Negroes aforesaid and of and in and to every part and Part of them of unto him the said Daniel Greene Esq. and Jacob Woolford their Heirs Executors Administrators and Assigns and their own proper Heirs and Assigns for ever And for the better Perceiving and Enjoyment of the said several Sums and Sums of Money hereby Assigned and Transferred aforesaid in the Schedule hereunto annexed He the said George Johnson hath Made Ordained Constituted Appointed and Deputed and by these Presents doth Make Ordain Constitute Appoint and Depute the said Daniel Greene Esq. and Jacob Woolford his true lawfull and lawfull Attorneys in the Name of him the said George Johnson his Executors Administrators or otherwise To Ask Receive Perceive and to demand and Receive the said several Sums and Sums of Money aforesaid and every or any Part thereof of and from the several and respective Person and Persons from whom the same are or shall be due and owing and also to Compound Releas and Agree to and with all and every Person and Persons for and concerning the Promises and covenants Receipts and Acquittances or other Discharges in the Name of the said George Johnson his Executors Administrators or otherwise To Make Deliver and Generally all and every other lawfull and reasonable Act and do thing and thing whatsoever within or about the Premises in

or discharging the promise or any part thereof shall be lawful and necessary to do perform any or more in as ample manner and sort to all intent and purpose as the said George Johnson his Executor or Assigns might or lawfully might do and lawfully do and all and whosoever the said Daniel Groves Esq. and Jacob Woolford their Executors or Assigns or any of them shall lawfully do or lawfully be bound to do in or about the promise the said George Johnson doth hereby for himself his Heirs Executors and Assigns Covenant to allow that they and Conform unto the said George Johnson for himself his Heirs Executors and Assigns both present promise and agree to and with the said Daniel Groves Esq. and Jacob Woolford their Executors and Assigns by these presents in manner and form following (that is to say) That the said George Johnson or any other Person or persons by or under his Authority means or procurement hath not directly or indirectly borrowed or released or discharged given or assigned any of the said debts sums of Money Bonds or Notes Goods Chattels Wares Merchandises or Hogsheads now and in the future hereunto annexed unto any other Person or Persons whatsoever And that the said George Johnson his Executor or Assigns shall not now or at any time hereafter without the consent of the said Daniel Groves and Jacob Woolford their Executors or Assigns release discharge and make void the debts or sums of Money Bonds or Notes hereby assigned and mentioned in the said Schedule hereunto annexed or any of them or any part thereof but shall and will at all times hereafter without the consent upon request of the said Daniel Groves Esq. and Jacob Woolford their Executors or Assigns and assist the said Daniel Groves Esq. and Jacob Woolford their Executors or Assigns in the making and making up of all Accounts and Bookings between him the said George Johnson and the several Persons from whom the said debts sums and sums of Money were made in the said Schedule hereunto annexed and hereby assigned according to the true intent and meaning of these presents And that the said George Johnson his Executor or Assigns shall and will at the like request and at the Cost and Charge of the said George Johnson or his Executors or Assigns maintain and bear all lawfull Actions Proceedings and Proceedings of the said Daniel Groves Esq. and Jacob Woolford their Executors and Assigns that shall be brought and prosecuted concerning any the said debts sums or sums of Money And also make and do unto such further and other reasonable charges of Attorney's Fees and Disburse in the Case for the further and better enabling the said Daniel Groves Esq. and Jacob Woolford their Executors and Assigns to recover and receive the said debts sums and sums of Money for the proper use and benefit of the said Daniel Groves Esq. and Jacob Woolford their Executors and Assigns or either of them as by the said Daniel Groves Esq. and Jacob Woolford their Executors and Assigns or any of them or their Councils should in the Law shall lawfully demand and request In Witness whereof the said George Johnson hath hereunto set his Hand and Seal this day of July last above written at London and Subscribed in the presence of
