 N: 32 and State of South Carolina, being of sound Mind Memory and understanding
 Blessed be Almighty God for the same. Do make this my last Will and Testa-
 ment in manner and form following viz: I first give devise and bequeath
 unto my beloved daughter Hannah Crosby, for her own use and benefit during
 her natural life, my Negro woman Mariah with four of her children named Sally
 Charles, Joe and Jane, and at and after the death of my Daughter Hannah Crosby
 I then give and bequeath the above named Negroes Mariah Sally Charles and Joe
 and Jane unto my Beloved Grand Daughter Margaret I Crosby for her own use
 and benefit during her natural life, and at and after the death of my grand
 daughter Margaret I Crosby I then give and bequeath the above named five Negroes
 with all their future issue and increase unto the Heir of my said Grand daughter
 Margaret I Crosby lawfully begotten of her body forever. But should the said Mar-
 garet I Crosby leave no issue living at her death, then my Will is, that the said
 Negroes, do go to her nearest kin, share and share alike.

Secondly I give devise and bequeath unto my beloved Daughter Mary Cooper
 for her own ^{proper} use and benefit during her natural life my two Negro women Kelly
 and Kate, also my two Negro Boys Peter and Gabriel and at, and after the death
 of my daughter Mary Cooper, I then give and bequeath the above named
 Negroes Kelly, Kate, Peter and Gabriel, with all their future issue and increase
 unto the heir of my said daughter Mary Cooper lawfully begotten of her body
 for ever, share and share alike.

Thirdly. I give Devise and Bequeath, the residue of all my property, in
 any name or nature whatsoever not yet

negroes, do go to her nearest kin, share and share alike.

Secondly I give devise and bequeath unto my beloved Daughter Mary Cooper for her own ^{proper} use and benefit during her natural life my two negro women Nelly and Kate, also my two Negro Boys Peter and Gabriel and at, and after the death of my daughter Mary Cooper, I then give and bequeath the above named negroes Nelly, Kate, Peter and Gabriel, with all their future issue and increase unto the heirs of my said daughter Mary Cooper lawfully begotten of her body for ever, share and share alike.

Thirdly I give Devise and Bequeath, the residue of all my property, in any manner or manner whatsoever, not otherwise, above disposed of unto my Beloved Daughter Mary Cooper for her self and Heirs for ever. And Lastly I hereby nominate constitute and appoint Mr Nathaniel Cooper my only Executor of this my last Will and Testament.
