South Carolina Mortgage from Henry Gibbs to Charles Lowndes

Know all men by these presents that I Henry Gibbs of Charles Town in the Province of South Carolina for and in consideration of a bond & Judgment bearing Date with these Presents wherein I the said Henry Gibbs am held & firmly bound unto M<sup>r</sup> Charles Lowndes in the penal sum of five hundred Pounds of like Money as appraised with Lawfull Interest on the fifteenth Day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & thirty three as by the said record Obligation Condition and Judgment does more at large appear & for the better securing the said sum of five hundred Pounds with Lawfull Interest to be paid as appraised HAVE bargained sold & delivered to by these presents in due form of Law to bargain sell & deliver unto the said Charles Lowndes his heirs Executors & assigns all those Negroes commonly called & known by the Names of Jary Sampson Dutches Maria & Cuffe To have and to hold the said Bargained Premises unto the said Charles Lowndes his heirs Executors & assigns forever & the said Henry Gibbs his Executors & Assigns the said Bargained Premises unto the said Charles Lowndes his Executors & Assigns against all Persons shall & Will warrant and for ever defend by these presents notwithstanding that if the said Henry Gibbs his heirs Executors & Assigns do well and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the said Charles Lowndes his heirs Executors & Assigns the sum of three hundred Pounds with Lawfull Interest at or before the fifteenth Day of April one thousand & seven hundred & thirty three according to the true Intent & Meaning of the above Recited Obligation & Condition for redemption for the above Bargained Premises then this Present Bill of Sale to be void or else to remain in full force & Virtue. In Witness whereof I have hereunto put my hand & Seal the fifteenth Day of April one thousand seven hundred & thirty three.
