Mortgage from Henry Gibbs to Charles Lovende

fully bound unto Maj<sup>r</sup> Charles Lovende in the sum of One hundred  
Pounds Current money of S<sup>t</sup> Carolina Conditioned for the payment of those hundred  
Pounds of like Money as aforesaid with Lawfull Interest on the fifteenth Day of  
April in the year of our Lord one thousand Seven hundred & thirty three, as by  
the said Bond Obligation, Condition and Judgment Declared at Large appears  
& for the better securing the Performance of and making Payment with Lawfull  
Interest to be paid as aforesaid. Nowe bargained, sold & Delivere  
by these presents in Due form of Lawe Bargain Sale & Deliver unto the said  
Charles Lovende his Heirs, Executors, Administrators, or assigns the Negro Community  
called so hunc by the Names of Dasy, Sampson, Dutches, Maria & Cuffe  
So have and to hold the said Bargained Promises unto the

his Esq<sup>r</sup> & Admirals their said Bargained Promises unto the said Charles Lovende  
his Heirs, Executors, Administrators, or assigns, against all Persons Shall & Will, warrant and for  
ever defend by these Presents, notwithstanding that of the said Henry Gibbs his heirs,  
executors, Administrators, Do well and Truly Pay or Cause to be paid unto the said Charles  
Lovende his Heirs, Executors, Administrators or assigns the sum of those hundred Pounds  
with Lawfull Interest at or before the fifteenth Day of April one thousand &  
Seven hundred & Thirty three, According to the former intent & Meaning of  
the above Recited Obligation & Condition, for remittance for the above  
Bargained Promises, then the present Bill of Sale to be void or else to remain

horses unto the said Charles Bonnides, his Executors, Aditors  
and Assigns, as his and their own proper chattels and right  
and to his and their own proper use and behoof for ever  
And I the said John Edwards do for myself, my Executors  
and Aditors covenant and grant to and with the said  
Charles, his Execut<sup>r</sup>, Adm<sup>r</sup> and Assigns, that I the said  
John at the time of Sealing & Delivery of these presents  
am the true and lawful Owner and Proprietor of the  
Properties hereby granted, and that I have full power &  
Authority to dispose and sell the same in manner aforesd:  
and that it shall be Lawful to and for the said Charles  
his Execut<sup>r</sup> & Adm<sup>r</sup> to Assigns, at any time after the  
first day of Sept<sup>r</sup> next, To have, take and hold the  
premises, without any impediment or molestation of me  
the said John, my Execut<sup>r</sup>, Adm<sup>r</sup> or Assigns or any person  
claiming under me, them or any of us: Provided  
Nevertheless that if the said Mr. Edwards, my

Excut<sup>r</sup> or Adm<sup>r</sup> shall not and truly pay or  
cause to be paid unto the said Charles Bonnides his  
Excut<sup>r</sup>, Adm<sup>r</sup> or Assigns the said sum of Ninety Eight  
Pounds fifteen Shillings and no pence afterward, with
