No 3 - Rose of the State aforesaid, planter, being of sound Mind and Memory,
and in my perfect senses, Do make publish and declare this Instrument
of Writing, to be my last Will and Testament, in manner and form following
Viz; I give, devise and bequeath to my son James Rose and to his heirs
and assigns forever, my plantations and Tracts of Land situated and being

in the parishes of Christ Church and St. Thomas, together with all
Buildings and Appurtenances, on the express condition that he shall pay
or cause to be paid to each of my Daughters Miss Susan Rose, and Miss
Maria Rutledge, within Three Years after my Decease; Five Thousand
Dollars each, to them and their Heirs forever. Item, I give to my said son James
Rose, my Stock of plantation Horses, Mules, Stock of Cattle, Sheep and Pigs, with
all plantation tools Implements of Husbandry, together with all the household
Furniture, Bedding, and Table Linen, on and belonging to the plantations afore-
said. Item, I give and bequeath to my aforesaid Son, my Gold watch, chain
and seals which he now wears, and also all my Books. - I also give to my son
the following Servants, born or to be born, with their issue and increase after
the date of this my Will, viz; Shoram, Mary, Ned, George & Martha, Marian and
her Four children, whose names I do not now recollect. - Whereas I stand indebted
to my Son, on my Bond, bequeathed to him by his late Grandfather John
Rose of London, in the Kingdom of Great Britain, dated November 1st One
Thousand Seven Hundred and Ninety four, for the sum of Four Thousand
Pounds Sterling, with Interest from the date, now therefore, as no part of
the principal or Interest on the said Bond has been paid to my Son James
Rose, it becomes an onerous, tho' just debt against my Estate, I now most
solemnly request and urge my beloved Son, libtally to consider the cir-
cumstances of his Sisters, in recovering the amount due him on the Bond,
which has not been misemployed by me in promoting their general In-
