 Amen, Know all men This to be my last Will and Testament, and
 to be acknowledged by all courts of Justice & Equity in this State. I do
 hereby Will and ordain that after my death, That after all my just
 Debts are paid, That all my property of whatever description be equally
 divided amongst my four children, The eldest Issak, the second
 a girl named Meriam, The third named Joseph and the fourth
 named Israel. And I hereby Appoint M^r Albert Happoldt as my
 lawful Executor, and directs that the said Executor to apply the
 Income of my property to be given to the Mother named Susan Smith
 of the aforesaid children Issak, Meriam, Joseph and Israel for their
 Support and Maintenance. And further the said Executor is author-
 ized my negro wench named Mintie, either to sell her or hire her out
 to bring in wages to be applied to the support of the children. I do
 further request my Executor to continue the Religious worship of my
 Children in the same Jewish faith as myself and my ancestors. I
 do deliver my soul to Almighty God and depart in peace with man-
 kind. Done on Charleston neck September 17th 1838
