

Box 23 In the Name of God, Amen I, Isaac Bateman free coloured man
No. 24 of Charleston Neck in the State of South Carolina, being of sound mind and
memory, do make and publish this my last Will and Testament: I do
hereby give to my grand daughter Mary Cochran my house and lot on
the East side of meeting Street three doors from the corner. To my grand
daughter Jane Cochran, I give my house in the rear of the same lot be-
queathed to Mary Cochran, with the ground on which said house stands.
To my Daughter Mary Ann I give the use of the Shed on the same lot, as
long as she chooses to occupy it. To Mr. Charles Frazer I bequeath my Ser-
vant Nancy in trust, for her own use, and benefit, believing he will protect
her, and take care of her, and act as her guardian. To my grand daughter
Sarah Cochran I give the house and lot in which I now reside, it being
north of the lot bequeathed to Mary Cochran and if said Sarah should
die without issue then I will that said house and lot, be given to my great
grandson Daniel Isaac Cochran; and if he should not survive said Sarah,
then the said house and lot to go to my great grand son Wellington Cochran.
And it is my will that the above named Mary, and Jane Cochran shall
not sell their respective portions out of the family: If I should die possessed
of any money I hereby bequeath to my grandson Morris Cochran, Fifty
Doll. out of which money he shall pay to his son Wellington Ten Dollars.
To my great grandson Daniel Isaac Cochran I give, and bequeath Forty
Doll. I hereby appoint Samuel Cochran my son in Law guardian for his chil-
dren, and his grand children. I make and constitute Charles Frazer Esq.
my Executor of this last Will and Testament hereby revoking all former wills.

Sarah Cochran I give the house and lot in which I now reside, it being
north of the lot bequeathed to Mary Cochran and if said Sarah should
die without issue then I will that said house and lot, be given to my great
grandson Daniel Isaac Cochran; and if he should not survive said Sarah,
then the said house and lot to go to my great grand son Willington Cochran.
And it is my will that the above named Mary, and Jane Cochran shall
not sell their respective portions out of the family; If I should die possessed
of any money I hereby bequeath to my grandson Morris Cochran, Fifty
Doll: out of which money he shall pay to his son Willington Ten Dollars.

To my great grandson Daniel Isaac Cochran I give, and bequeath Forty
Doll: I hereby appoint Samuel Cochran my son in Law guardian for his chil-
dren, and his grand children. — I make and constitute Charles Fraser Esq:
my Executor of this last Will and Testament hereby revoking all former Wills,
by me hitherto made: and have hereunto set my hand and Seal this fourth day
of March One thousand Eight hundred and Forty three.
