And being desirous to dispose of all such worldly Estate as it hath  
pleased Almighty God to bless me with do desire that my dearly  
Beloved wife Mary Lamb do have and hold all and singular my pro-  
-perty both personal and Real {Estate} after my just debts are paid  
during her lifetime and all monies arising therefrom either  
from selling of wood, cotton or Rice &c to be disposed off at her  
free will and pleasure but should there be any over plus to the  
use of an increase of my Estate property and lastly I desire that  
immediately after the death of my dearly beloved wife Mary  
Lamb, my whole estate both personal and Real be sold at publick  
-outcry and all monies arising therefrom or coming thereto to being  
by my qualified Executors Received I desire that they pay over to  
the Missionary Society five hundred Dollars for the support of  
-Missions and propagation of the gospel of Christ Jesus our Lord  
after which I desire that all monies still remaining to be equal-  
-ly divided between my Brothers and sisters John Lamb & the  
whole of them.

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immediately after the death of my dearly beloved wife Mary Lamb, my whole estate both personal and Real be sold at public outcry and all monies arising therefrom or coming thence to being by my qualified Executors Received I desire that they pay over to the Missionary Society five hundred Dollars for the support of Missions and propagation of the gospel of Christ Jesus our Lord after which I desire that all monies still remaining to be equally divided between my Brothers and sister John Lamb (of the whole blood) Ann Warton, James Warton, Thomas Warton and Maria Warton } of the half blood } and lastly I do constitute and appoint John C. Phillips of St. Stephens and H. M. Hart of Charles town my Executors of this my last Will and Testament by me hereof made. In testimony whereof I hereunto set my hand and affix my seal this twenty second day of December and in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty five and fifty ninth year of American Independence.
