life and after her death I bequeath the said Slaves and their issue ^{as} aforesaid to
my Nephew James McBride Grimke to him and his Executors Administrators and
assigns forever. Item - I will and bequeath unto my said Nephew James
McBride Grimke the following Slaves, Harriet, Sue, Chloe, Fanny, Nello,
William, Bob, John, Hercules, Lary and her two youngest children now
living, Rose and Diana with all their future issue and increase for and
during the term of his natural life, Should he die without leaving lawful
issue at the time of his death then in that case I will and bequeath the said
Slaves and their issue and increase unto his Brother John Grimke Drayton to
him his Executors Administrators and assigns forever, but should the said
James McBride Grimke die leaving lawful issue, then I will and bequeath the
said Negro Slaves and their issue and increase to such his lawful issue forever
to be divided between them if more than one according to law, or in such man-
ner and proportion as the said James McBride Grimke shall by will or

and testament appoint and direct. Item I also will and bequeath to my said nephew
James M^cBride Grinke, my Carriage and horses and my mare Kitty and all my
household furniture in town to him, his Executors, administrators and assigns forever.
Item I will and bequeath the Slaves, Hetch, and Maria his wife, Sue, Hercules
and Gabriel their children, Becky, Cedric, Hercules, and Jenny his wife together with
all their future issue and increase to my Nephew John Grinke Drayton for and during
the term of his natural life; Should he die without leaving lawful issue at the time
of his death then in that case I will and bequeath the said Slaves last mentioned
unto his ^{own} Brothers James M^cBride Grinke and Theodore Drayton Grinke to them
their Executors, Administrators and assigns to be equally divided between them. But
should the said John Grinke Drayton die leaving lawful issue then I will and
bequeath the said last mentioned Slaves together with their issue and increase unto
such lawful issue forever - to be divided between them if more than one according to
law; or in such manner and proportion as the said John Grinke Drayton shall by
his last will and testament appoint and direct. Item I will and bequeath unto
the said John Grinke Drayton all my Stock of Cattle, Sheep, Hogs, horses, mules and
all my farming utensils, carts, wagons, ploughs, with all the household and kitchen
furniture in my house and premises at Magnolia on Ashley River and all my
Silver Plate, to him, his Executors Administrators and assigns forever. Item I will
and bequeath unto my Nephew Theodore D Grinke the Slaves - Joseph,
Jacob, Marian and Lizzy with all their future issue and increase to him
his Executors Administrators and assigns forever. Should either of my
said Nephews John Grinke Drayton, Theodore D Grinke or James M^c
Bride Grinke die before me - I will that all the property hereby bequeathed
to him shall be equally divided between his surviving Brothers or shall go to

his Executors Administrators and assigns forever — I should either of my
said Nephews John Grinke Drayton, Theodore D Grinke or James M^c
Bride Grinke' die before me — I will that all the property hereby bequeathed
to him, shall be equally divided between his surviving Brothers, or shall pass to

No. 3 Jane Johnson, of the City of Charleston, in the said State, being of sound
and disposing mind and memory, do make this my last will and testament,
in manner following; that is to say: ^{my mind} Imprimis - It is my will that my
body be decently interred in the Burial Yard of the Second Presbyterian Church,
as near to the graves of my beloved parents as possible; and that a plain
but suitable Tomb Stone be placed over my grave, and I request my
brother William D Johnson, or if he should not survive me, my Executors
herein after named to see to the Execution of this part of my will. ^{Item} I
give and devise to my said brother William D Johnson the house and lot
at the corner of King Street and Blackbird Alley, where I now reside,
to him and his heirs and assigns forever. In trust for the sole and separate
use and behoof of A. B. Johnson.
