Item, I bequeath the rest of my personal property and devise the whole of the
real Estate which I may die seized and possessed of to the Reverend John Buckman
to him and to his heirs forever in trust for the sole use and benefit of Mary
Rockler during her natural life. And after the death of the said Mary Rockler

then in trust for the sole use and benefit of my said daughter, her heirs and assigns, during her natural life, and after her death, to the heirs of her body, living at her death, to be equally divided among them free from all limitations and trusts to them and to their heirs forever. It is my Will and my hereby expressed intention that they who are to have the said life Estates shall only receive the interests which shall from time to time arise from this said Personal Property and Real Estate. And the better to effect my intention I hereby authorize the said Trustee to sell or exchange any part or the whole of the said Personal Property and Real Estate provided that the proceeds arising from the said sale or exchange shall be invested in other property and held subject to the herein contained trusts.

Now and Lastly, I nominate the said Reverend John Bachman Executor of this my said last Will and Testament.
