No. 1 James Anderson of Christ Church Parish do make constitute and ap-
point this my last will and Testament, to wit. To my Wife Mary
Anderson I give all that I may possess at my death to her for the benefit
of herself and my three sons Batcheller Thomas & and James Anderson
and I do appoint her Executrix to this my Will — And at her death each
of my sons Batcheller & Thomas & Anderson shall be deemed and con-
sidered of full age and qualify as my Executors without her death should
happen before the close of the year one thousand Eight hundred and forty three
then I appoint George I White of this Parish Executor to act for my three Sons
untill they severally arrive at the age of twenty one years but should my
wife Mary Anderson live until the year one thousand Eight hundred and
forty Eight or after that each of my three Sons shall have the right of quali-
fying as Executors — In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
& Seal this twenty third day of April one thousand Eight hundred and
forty.
