City of Charleston my House and Lot of Land adjoining thereto on Minorsy
Street a Bond and Mortgage due to me from Mess^{rs} Harriet Curry and
Potsch and a debt owing to me from the Estate and Heirs of Mrs Susan
Ann Subbick deceased and also all other property and Estate of every
kind and nature whatsoever to my said beloved Wife Sarah I Curry for
and during the term of her natural life and from and immediately
