N^o. 2. of Prince William Parish in the said State do make this my last Will
and Testament; First It is my Will that my just debt be paid out of
the income of my Estate as soon as possible, if practicable, but if this should
not appear to my executor to be practicable, then I authorize and empower
my executor to sell such part of my Estate real and personal for the
purpose of paying my debt as he may deem proper; Secondly, after
my just debt shall have been paid it is my Will that my whole property
real and personal shall be equally divided between my Wife Ann
Miles Guthrie and such of my Children as shall be then living, in the
manner following, that is to say; it is my Will that my Son shall take
their respective Shares of my Estate as they shall respectively attain the Age
of Twenty One Year; and my Daughters as soon as they shall respectively
Marry or attain the Age of Twenty One Year; and until such time my Children
shall be entitled to take and receive nothing from my Estate but a suitable
maintenance and every means of obtaining the best education - and the
Share to which each shall become entitled shall be estimated according to
the Value of the property at the time at which he or she shall be entitled to
receive the same; It is my Will with regard to my Wife that she shall
during her Widowhood, be entitled, in addition to her equal Share aforesaid
of my said Estate to the use of all my property which shall be under her
Care during the minority of all and each of my Sons, and during the Min-
ority, or until the Marriage of all and each of my Daughters according to the
provisions of this Will Without being accountable to them or to any one for
the income of the same.

Executor of the my last Will, With all the powers Voted in my said will
by the Will to be exercised by such One or more of them as shall qualify, and
act, but With no right to or interest in the income of my Estate, Which shall
in the event of the Marriage or Death of my said Wife accumulate for the
benefit of my Children, each Child to have an equal interest in the said
such time as he or she shall be entitled to receive his or her share of my Estate as

pointed as Executor With my Brother and friend herein before named, my
said Son not to act however until he shall attain the age of Twenty One
Years. I hereby revoke all former Will by me made. In Witness
