Testament. In the first place it is my Will and desire that all my
just debts should be paid out of my Estate, as soon after my death
as may be practicable, All the rest residue and remainder of my
Estate, both real and personal, I give devise and bequeath unto
my beloved Daughter Frances Corrie, the wife of Samuel Corrie,
of the City of, and State aforesaid Wheelwright, and the said
Samuel Corrie, for and during their natural lives, and in case
of the death of either of them then to the survivor for and during
his or her natural life, It is further my will and intention
that on the decease of the said Frances Corrie and Samuel Corrie
that my said Estate both real and personal should be sold equally
divided between the Children of the said Samuel and Frances Corrie
Share and Share alike. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set
my hand and seal this the sixteenth day of May in the year
of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and Forty -
