In the name of God Amen I James Johnston of Chapple Street Charleston neck being in good health of Body and mind do make and Publish this my last Will and Testament. which is as follows. ^{1st} I bequeath to my wife Lucinda Johnston otherwise Dillon one fifth part of all my real personal and chattle Property at the time of my death for her own use and to be at her disposal as she may think fit. ^{2^d} I bequeath to my Daughter Letitia Johnston otherwise Gee, one fifth part of all the real, personal or Chattle property, I am possessed of or entitled to at my Death, for her own use and to be disposed of as she may think proper. ^{3rd} I bequeath to my Daughter Mary Johnston otherwise Mcfeters one fifth part of all the real, personal or chattle Property or Estate I am posed of at the time of my Death to be disposed of as she thinks proper. ^{4th} I bequeath to my Daughter Margrett Johnston otherwise Allison one fifth part of all the real Personal or Chattle Property intitled to or posed of at the time of my Death for her own use and to be disposed of as she thinks proper. ^{5th} I Bequeath to my Daughter Charlott Johnston one fifth part of all the real, Personal, and Chattle Property i am posed of or intitled to at the time of my Death for her own use and to be disposed of as she thinks proper. ^{6th} and if any of the aforesaid Legatees dies before me, their share to be equally divided amongst their Successers.
