Then I direct that all my Real & personal estate of every nature and kind whatsoever and wheresoever the same shall or may be situate be sold as soon as convenient after my decease by my Executors hereinafter named, either at public or private sale, either for cash or on a credit as to my Executors shall seem most to the advantage of my estate and for that purpose, I do hereby authorize and empower my Executors or such of them as shall qualify and act to make good & sufficient titles and conveyances and Bills of Sale to the purchaser's thereof or of any part thereof and the moneys arising from such sale together with what money may be collected from debts due and all other my real & personal estate I give devise and bequeath, the interest income dividends and profits thereof unto my much esteemed and faithful friend Patrick Duncan for and during the term of his natural life and from and immediately after his death then I give devise and bequeath the said principal of my said estate unto my much loved Brother Robert and my sister Elizabeth Mary and Jane and to their heirs Executors Administrators and assigns forever to be divided

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as witnesses thereto.
