my last Will and testament. Imprimis I direct that all
my just debts be paid. Item I give and bequeath the negro fellow
Joan left me by my Sister Catharine Davis to Jane C J Hayden
to her and her heirs forever. Item I bequeath and devise the rest and
residue of my personal property and real Estate which I do see or
and possessed or to which I may be entitled to in Equity or at Law to
my Children Emma C E Morris Jane C J Hayden and Thomas D
Hayden to be equally divided between them share and share alike
to them and their heirs forever. Item and lastly I appoint James
C Morris my Executor. Witness my hand and seal this the Twenty
ninth of March 1839 and in the 63^d year of American Independence
