

Prob of Amos to James Macfarson granted to his widow Mary Macfarson

By the Honble Arthur Middleton Esq. President and Col
in Chief of this his Majesty's Province of South Carolina
and Ordinary of the same.

To Mary Macfarlane Widow.

Whereas James Macfarson late of Dorchester in this Province of New
Dorset deceased lately died intestate having whilst he lived and at the time of his
Death Divers Goods Rights and Credits within the Province aforesaid by
names whereof the full Description and Power of Granting the same hath
already singular the Goods Rights and Credits of the said James Macfarson Deceased
and also the Auditing the Accounts Calculations and Apportionings of the said
Administration and a final Discharge of the same to his Manifestly known to
belong I Desiring that the Goods Rights and Credits of the said Deceased might
well and truly Administered Converted and Disposed of To the best Grant unto
the said Mary Macfarson (in whose Fidelity in this behalfs I very much Doubt)
Full power by the Honor of these presents to Administer the Goods Rights and
Credits of the said Deceased whilst to him in his Life time and at the time of his
Death did belong And to Ask Collect Levy receive and receive the same and to
Pay the Debts in which the said Deceased stood Obligated To for forth and the said
Goods Rights and Credits will Dispose according to their rate and Order of Law
Doing first Sworn on the Holy Evangelists of Almighty God to make a true and
perfect Inventory thereof and to Exhibit the same into the Secretarys Office in
Charlton Town in Order to be Recorded at or before the First Day of April next
next Ensuing and to render a Just and true Account Calculations and Apportioning
of the said Administration when thereunto required And I Do Ordain Depute and
Constitute you the said Mary Macfarson Administering of all and singular the Goods
Rights and Credits of the said Deceased

be Directed unto by Mary Macfarlan Administratrix of the Estate and Goods of
James Macfarlan late of Newchester in this Province Schoolmaster Deceased and whatsoever
any of his Goods effects and Debts are or do remain within the said Ports and Harbours
which shall be shewn to You by the said Mary Macfarlan and their Deeds and Apprais all
and return the said Goods and Effects to the said James Macfarlan or to his Creditors to make
a full and sufficient presentment and appraisement and to deliver the same to the said Creditors
under your Hands or three or four of You into the Secretarys Office in Charles Towne in order to
be returned on or before the first Day of April next ensuing
