List of Deceased Gentleman Macferson granted to his Widower Mary Macferson

By the Honorable Arthur Middleton Esq^r President and Gen^r in Chief of this His Majesty's Province of South Carolina and Ordinary of the same. —

To Mary Macferson Widower.

Whereas James Macferson late of Dorchester in this Province deceased left his Estate having whilst he lived and at the time of his Death Debts, Goods, Rights and Credits within the Province of South Carolina and Ordinance of the same — means wherof he full Disposed and Power of Granting the Administration of all and singular the Goods Rights and Credits of his said James Macferson Deceased and also the rendering the Accounts Calculations and Payments of the said Administration and a final Distribution of the same to his said Mary his only Legatee by Will I Desiring that the Goods Rights and Credits of the said Deceased may well and truly Administered Executed and Disposed of Duly by Granting to his said Mary Macferson (in whose Fidelity in this behalf I hereby make Surety) full power by her Tenor of these presents to Administer the Goods Rights and Credits of the said Deceased which to him in his lifetime and at the time of his Death did belong and to ask Collectors to receive and receive the same and to pay the Debts in which the said Deceased stood Obliged so far forth as the said Goods Rights and Credits will afford according to this: late and Order of Granting first Sworne on the Holy Evangelist of Almighty God to me before two perfect Justices hereof and to exhibit the same into the Presidents Office at Charles Towne in Order to be Recorded at or before the First Day of April next ensuing and to render a just and true Account Calculated and forthcoming of the said Administration when thereunto required And I do Oath and Solemnly Constitute you the said Mary Macferson Administrator of all and singular the Goods Rights and Credits of the said Deceased
