of January in the year of Our Lord One thousand seven hundred and twenty nine and by
the said Charles Hill and Bondors doth consent to give and for the better
Securing the said Quantity of Nineteen thousand pounds weight of good Merchantable
Wool and Barrells to be paid a certain Mortgage of the said Charles Hill
Hill Two Negroes More named Jack and Simon To have and to hold the said Bargained
Promises unto the said Charles Hill his Executors Administrators and Assignors for ever and the said
John Bird his Executors and Assignors the said Mortgage Promises unto the said Charles
Hill his Executors Administrators and Assignors against all persons shall and will warrant and
for ever Defend by these presents Provided Nevertheless that if the said John Bird his
Executors Administrators or Assignors do well and truly pay or Cause to be paid unto the said
Charles Hill his Executors Administrators or Assignors the said Quantity of Nineteen thousand pounds
weight of Merchantable Wool and Barrells on the Day of Charles's Tenth on the said
Fifth day of January in the year of Our Lord One thousand seven hundred and twenty
nine according to the true intent and meaning of the above written Obligors and Bondors
for redemption of the above said Bargained Promises then this Present Bill of Sale to
