one hundred and twenty Pounds or after the first day of March Seventeen hundred
and Thirty Two Without any Deduction of a Payment out of the same then these
Presents and Every Article and Sentence herein Contained shall be void &
be utterly void & of none Effect any thing herein Contained to the Contrary hereof
in any Manner notwithstanding In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and
Seal this first day September Anno Domini Seventeen hundred and Thirty Two
