Know all men by these presents That we John Laurence of Charles Town in Berkley County in the province of Carolina Planter, and Lewis Gaudin of the province of the same are held & firmly bound unto Elias Hony of the same county aforesaid planter the sum of two hundred pounds full money of the province of the said, to be paid to the said Elias Hony or to his certain Attornies his Ex^{or} or assigns, To with payment well & to be made by us selves and either of us, our, or either of our heirs Ex^{or} and assigns in the whole or for the whole part, severally & jointly by these presents that we have made Dated the Twenty fifth Day of November in the year of our said overthousand seven hundred & Twenty eight and in the second year of his Maj^{ty}

The condition of this obligation is that that whereas the above named Elias Hony Administrator of all and singular the estate of Peter Gaudin deceased hath on or before this sealing and delivery hereof paid and disbursed unto the above bounden John Laurence for the full proper use and behoof of Peter Laurence (his nephew) Coheir to the estate of the said Peter Gaudin Deceased The full sum of Twenty eight pounds full money aforesaid, as stated above being the full sum of the portion Due unto the said Peter Laurence out of the estate and the above bounden John Laurence & Lewis Gaudin or either of them have hereby agreed to acquit discharge and have hereunto the within named Elias Hony his Ex^{or} and assigns, if therefore the said John Laurence and Lewis Gaudin and either of them then or either of them Ex^{or} and assigns shall and so from time to time and at all times hereafter fully and clearly acquit discharge & discharge or else well & sufficiently have satisfied & kept harmless the said Elias Hony his Ex^{or} and assigns & every of them as well of, from, and against the said Peter Laurence his Executors as well and assigns as also of, from, or against all other persons who were or shall be concerning the payment of this sum of Twenty eight pounds to the above bounden John Laurence for the use of Peter Laurence aforesaid and of and from all actions, suits, Ex^{or} & Damages Expenses, and demands whatsoever that the said Elias Hony his Ex^{or} and assigns or assigns shall hereafter happen to incur or sustain or be put unto, for or by reason of the payment of this said sum of Twenty eight pounds unto the above bounden John Laurence for the use

of the said Peter Laurence as aforesaid, that then the
present obligation shall cease & determine, and be
void & of non effect, or else to stand abiding
remain and be in full power force & virtue

piece or parcel of Land containing two hundred
thirty seven Acres situate & being in Berkeley County
in the Province aforesaid & bounded & bounded to the
North East on the Land of George Benson to the South
East on Josephine Sound to the West on the Land of
Mary Mitchell & to the North West on the Land of
John Young together with the right titles Interest
Claim & Demand whatsoever wth I now have or which
any or either of my heirs Esq^r Administrators or
Assignes may hereafter have of to or in the said
Granted premises or any part thereof to have &
to hold the said Lands unto him the said Tho. Lorey
Esq^r his heirs & assigns forever, absolutely wth out
any manner of Condition as I the said Thomas Lorey
Esq^r have fully freely & absolutely, & of my own
accord sett & putt in further Testimony I do
Witness whereof I have hereunto sett my hand
& seal this twenty eighth Day of July in the
Year of our Lord 1729
